What is CMV?

CMV is a common virus that is often overlooked as it is unusual for a CMV infection to cause illness in a healthy person.

However, if a woman is infected while pregnant, she can pass the infection to her unborn child. In this case, the baby may have or develop lifelong disabilities, such as hearing loss, learning problems, or vision abnormalities; and can even die.

Is treatment available?

Currently, there are no approved vaccines or treatments to prevent CMV infection.

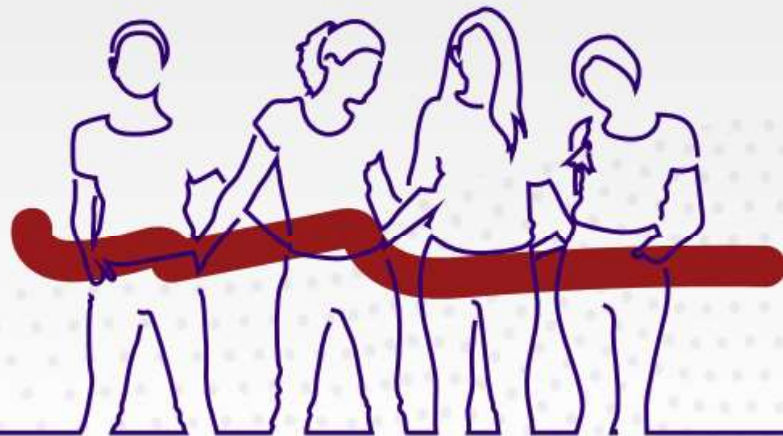
